



# 16mm Update

ur good wishes to all our readers for a Happy and Healthy 2017.

The period of boiler steam testing is nearly upon us, which should be completed by the end of March. We are pleased to announce that Glyn Tandy will be joining Gordon Miles in getting these tests completed as smoothly as possible. Please make prior arrangements with Gordon or Glyn.

At this time of year we would venture a few tips to help steaming.

- Store your locos over-night inside the warm house.
- 2. Store gas tanks also inside.
- 3. Switch to 30% Propane/70% Butane gas mixture.
- 4. If possible, when at the track, keep your gas canister in an inside pocket to keep it warm.
- Shake canister before use.
- 6. When initially lighting up gently rock the loco to ensure better mixing or the liquid gas mixture.

The period of boiler steam testing is nearly upon us, which should be completed by the end of March. We are pleased to announce that Glyn Tandy will be joining Gordon Miles in getting these tests completed as smoothly as possible. Please make prior arrangements with Gordon or Glyn.

# **Boiler Testing**

f you require a Boiler Test, please remember that you need to book it with one of the Boiler Testers. Also you should have all the paperwork with you - that's all the past Test Certificates and the *Written Scheme of Examination*! You have kept them, haven't you?

If you are presenting your loco for its 4-yearly Hydraulic Test please note that you cannot expect the Boiler Tester to provide the necessary blanking plugs. You should have a complete set of blanking plugs for each of your locos, one of which must have a **male**  $^{1}/_{4}$ " x 40TPI fitting to allow the connection of the test pump and gauge. The threaded portion of this should be at least  $^{3}/_{8}$ " (10mm) long with a 60 degree countersink to take a standard nipple.

Please pump the boiler up at home to check that there are no leaks.
